(2) Oral Examination (First examination or First and Second Examination)				
① Oral Examination	The applicant is requested to make a 10 minute presentation about their master's thesis (or equivalen t research output) and their Doctoral Course research plan. The applicant is examined after their presentation. However, applicants who can submit their master's thesis (or equivalent) by the oral examination day, can take the second examination at the same time and are requested to make a 20 minute presentation about their master thesis (or equivalent) and Doctoral Course research plan. The applicants are examined after the presentation.			
② Prior sumbission material	Submit the documents by the designated date. Except for figures and tables, the fonts should be larger than 18 points. See the department website for an example.			
Presentation material for Oral Examination	Applicants are required to submit four pages of presentation material (eight pages if takin g the second examination concurrently), containing figures and tables.			
(3) Oral Examination (Second Examination)				
① Oral Examination	In the case that the applicant cannot submit their master's thesis (or equivalent) for the first examination, their master's thesis will be examined on another date. In the case of admissions in April 2024 for Schedule A, the second examination will be planned from the end of January to the beginning of February 2024. In the case of admissions in Octorber 2024 for Schedule B, the second examination will be planned
