

## Information of 2024 Entrance Examination: Master's Course

### Department of Ocean Technology, Policy, and Environment

#### 1 Examination

##### 1.1 Schedule A (Special Oral Examination is explained later)

(1) Written Examination	
① English	TOEFL-ITP will be conducted at Kashiwa Campus. The applicant can submit a valid TOEFL or TOEIC score sheet and use it for the applicant's English score. (A score sheet of TOEFL iBT Home Edition is acceptable.)
② Specialized Subjects	
• Fundamental Specialized Subject (problem is designed to evaluate logical thinking and basic mathematical skills)	Please check the website of OTPE for information of scope of examination and past examination questions.
• Essay on specialized subject	
(2) Oral Examination	Applicant is examined about undergraduate research and research interest in Master Course (10 minutes).

##### 1.2 Schedule B

(1) Written Examination	
① English	The applicant must submit a valid TOEFL or TOEIC score sheet. (A score sheet of TOEFL iBT Home Edition is acceptable.) Note that TOEFL-ITP will not be conducted for Schedule B.
② Specialized Subjects	
• Fundamental Specialized Subject (problem is designed to evaluate logical thinking and basic mathematical skills)	Same as Schedule A
• Essay on specialized subject	Same as Schedule A

#### 2. Examination Schedule

##### 2.1 Schedule A

The examination will be carried out at the designated venue at Kashiwa Campus. Always check the website of the OTPE for the latest information.

• Essay on specialized subject	August 21 (Mon) at Kashiwa Campus
(2) Oral Examination	August 21 (Mon) at Kashiwa Campus

##### 2.2 Schedule B

Planned for some time from the end of January to the beginning of February, 2024. The examination will be conducted in-person. Further information will be announced on the website of OTPE.

#### 3. Special Oral Examination

The examination will be carried out at the designated venue at Kashiwa Campus. Always check the website of the OTPE for the latest information.

(1) About the examination	
	For Schedule A, Special Oral Examination is given to applicants who achieved an outstanding academic record and who wish to enter this department as their first preference.
	Number of students selected by Special Oral Examination is about 10.
	Those who plan to take the Special Oral Examination should mark the checkbox on the Inquiry Sheet (Master's). Applicants will be informed of the screening results after a screening of the submitted documents. Those who pass the document screening are interviewed for the Special Oral Examination. Those who are not admitted by Special Oral Examination document screening may take the Regular Admission's Written and Oral Examinations. When an applicant takes the Regular Admission, the resubmission of the application is not required, except for a TOEFL or TOEIC score sheet submitted during the Application Period or by August 21, 2023, if they do not take TOEFL-ITP at Kashiwa Campus.
	Those who passed the Special Oral Examination are exempted from the Regular Admission's Written and Oral Examinations. Those who are not admitted by the Special Oral Examination may take the Regular Admission's Written and Oral Examinations. When an applicant takes the Regular Admission, the resubmission of the application is not required, except for a TOEFL or TOEIC score sheet submitted during the Application Period or by August 21, 2023, if they do not take TOEFL-ITP at Kashiwa Campus..

	Those who pass the Special Oral Examination may not change their numbered preferences for Programs (Advisors) indicated in the Inquiry Sheet after the examination. We will confirm your preference during the Special Oral Examination.
	Before submitting an application, applicants are recommended to contact prospective advisors and consult with them about their research plans.
(2) Contents of the examination	
① Oral examination	Applicants must make a presentation within 7 minutes regarding their motivation for applying to this department, and the research plan in the Master Course. Applicants are questioned for about 8 minutes following the presentation.
② Prior submission documents	You are required to submit a two sheet summary of your research plan, containing presentation material including figures and tables. The method of submission will be informed together with the Examination Admission Ticket. The fonts should be larger than 18 points, except for those in figures and tables. See the website of OTPE for an example.
(3) Examination Schedule	
① Date	July 1 (Sat.), 2023. The time and method of network connection will be announced later.
② Venue	6F3 Meeting Room, 6th Floor, Tansdisciplinary Stusy Bldg.
